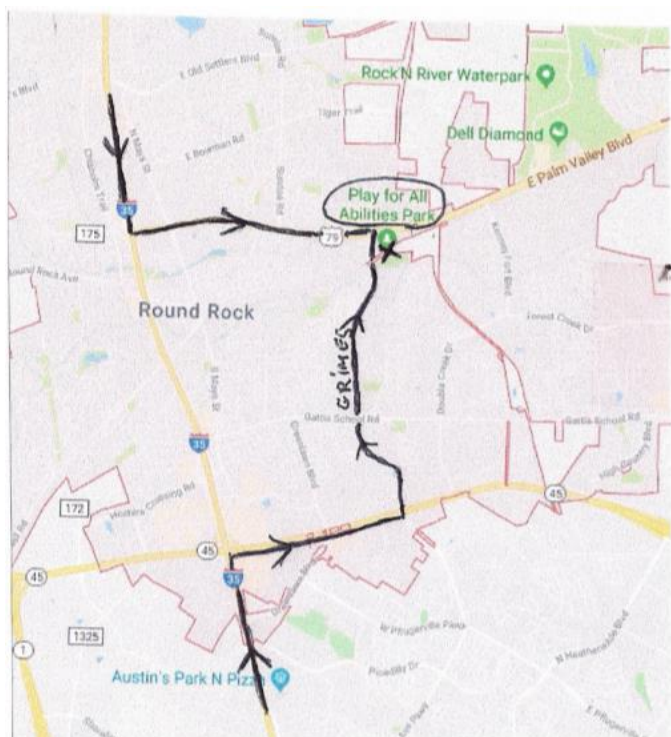


DIRECTIONS: Driving **N** on I 35, take exit #250, Louis Henna Blvd./SH 45. **R** on Louis Henna/SH 45. This is a frontage Rd. for the toll road but you will **not** enter the toll road. Travel about 1.5 miles, and at 3rd light, turn **L** on A.W.Grimes. Rd. Go about 2.5 miles, crossing Gattis School Rd. After 5th traffic light you go under a black overhead railway. Make **immediate R** into Rabb Park for All.

Driving **S** on I 35, take exit #253, Route 79/Hutto/Taylor. **L** on Route 79 for about 2 miles. **R** on A.W. Grimes. Almost immediately you pass under a black overhead railway. At first traffic light, make a U-turn to go back and enter the Rabb Park for All at the black overpass.

Brushy Creek/Lake Creek Trails Round Rock, Texas

HISTORY:

Both the Brushy Creek East Trail and the Lake Creek Trail are managed by the City of Round Rock and are on the East side of I35. Eventually it is planned that they will connect with the Brushy Creek Trail West of I35 in Cedar Park, which is managed by Williamson County.

Our start point is at the Rabb Park For All Abilities. This land was given to the City of Round Rock by the Rabb Family in 1986. The original family home, built in 1970 on the banks of Brushy Creek, was badly damaged by flooding in 2010 and rebuilt in 2014 as a beautiful event location.

The special Park for All Abilities was opened in 2012 and then greatly expanded by 2016. It has been built so as to provide children with disabilities the opportunity to enjoy the park.

LOCATION Start/Finish: Rabb Park for All, 151 North A.W. Grimes Blvd. Round Rock, Tx. 78664. Park near rear of the park.

START / FINISH TIMES: Start between 8:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m., finish by 2:00 p.m.

ROUTE: There are two out and back cemented routes. One will go east to Freeman Park and return. The second heads west, enters historic Round Rock and turns around at the Baca Senior Center before going back to the start/finish. We therefore have possible 5/10/15/20k distances for your enjoyment.

WALK FEES:

All walkers (Credit or non-credit) are \$3.00.
Non-credit children under 12 are \$1.25 to cover AVA fee.

AWARDS: "B" awards from previous walks will be available. Children under 12 are eligible for a free "B" award.

DISCLAIMER: The Colorado River Walkers are not responsible for accidents, injuries, or any lost or stolen items during the event. Reasonable effort will be made to make this a safe, enjoyable event.

EVENT CONDITIONS: The event will be held regardless of weather conditions. All participants (including small children) must carry a Start Card. Walk route twice on same Start Card for additional distance credit. Events are noncompetitive. Walk, jog, or run at your own pace. Pets are allowed on the trail, but must remain on a leash with owner doing cleanup.

ELIGIBILITY: Everyone is welcome. These events are open to all, regardless of age, sex, creed, race or nationality. An adult must accompany children under age 12.

IVV CREDIT: This event is sanctioned by the American Volkssport Association (AVA), a member of the International Federation of Popular Sports (IVV) and counts toward acquisition of IVV Achievement Awards. IVV books may be purchased at the event for \$6.00. New Walker packets are available for \$5.00.

AMENITIES: Water and restrooms are available at the Start/Finish and at other places along the route.

Conduct: Participants are reminded that this event is open to all, including families. Please conduct yourself accordingly. The Colorado River Walkers retain the right to ask anyone engaging in offensive or inappropriate behavior to cease to participate and to leave the event area and facilities.
