

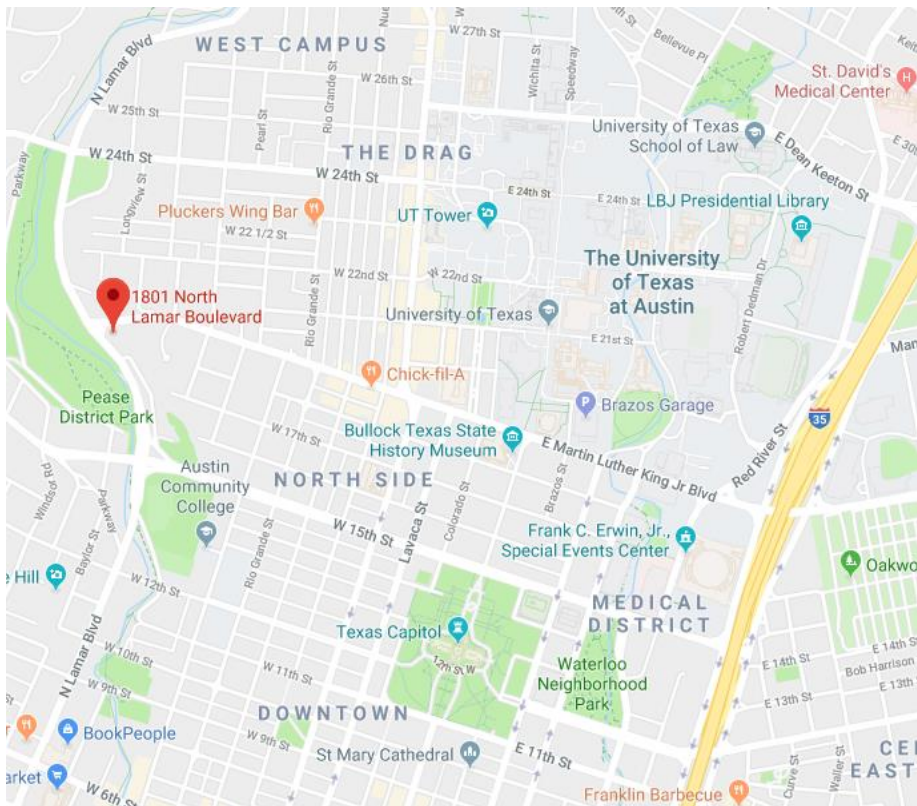
DIRECTIONS:

Coming from the South on IH35:

Take **Exit 235A**. Stay on frontage road to 15th Street. Turn **left on 15th St.** to Lamar Blvd - about 1 mile. **Turn right on Lamar** for about 0.3 mile to Martin Luther King Blvd. Turn **right** on Martin Luther King for a very short distance. Turn **right** into the parking lot behind the T3 building.

Coming from the North on IH35.

Take **Exit 235A**. Stay on frontage road to 15th Street. Turn **right on 15th St.** to Lamar Blvd - about 1 mile. **Turn right on Lamar** for about 0.3 mile to Martin Luther King Blvd. Turn **right** on Martin Luther King for a very short distance. SANCTIONED EVENT

Eligible for credit toward IVV Achievement Awards

DESCRIPTION: This walk showcases various cultural sights in the central Austin area. You will enter Pease Park and follow the recently opened Shoal Creek Trail to Lady Bird Lake allowing an experience of a green oasis in the middle of a bustling downtown corridor. The route will take you to the new central Austin Public Library opened in 2017 that boasts a rooftop garden with the largest solar installation in downtown Austin. Art works surround the building, as well. Continuing on you will pass many of Austin's cultural sights, both old and new. Some of those included will be the Bob Bullock State History Museum, outside sculptures on the University of Texas campus, the Caswell House, Judges Hill, the Blanton Museum of Art, and the Neill Cochran House Museum. Should you wish to visit any of the museums, they generally open at 10 a.m. and require an admission charge.

LOCATION Start/Finish: Start point is in the parking lot of the T3 building at 1801 N. Lamar, Austin TX. Access to the parking lot/start point is immediately in back of the building on Martin Luther King Blvd. **No restrooms at Start, but located about a 5 minute walk down the trail.**

START / FINISH TIMES: Start between 8:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m.; finish by 2:00 p.m.

ROUTE: Both the 5k and 10k routes are on paved city streets and groomed trails with periodic small hills. (1A).

AWARDS: "B" awards from previous walks will be available. Children under 12 will be eligible for a free "B" award.

FEES: "B" Award & IVV credit \$4.00
All walkers (credit or non-credit) \$3.00.
Children under 12 are \$1.25 to cover the AVA fee.

DISCLAIMER: The Colorado River Walkers are not responsible for accidents, injuries, or any lost or stolen items during the event. Reasonable effort will be made to make this a safe, enjoyable event.

EVENT CONDITIONS: The event will be held regardless of weather conditions. All participants (including small children) must carry a Start Card. Walk route twice on same Start Card for additional distance credit. Events are noncompetitive. Walk, jog, or run at your own pace. Pets are allowed on the trail, but must remain on a leash with owner responsible for cleanup.

ELIGIBILITY: Everyone is welcome. These events are open to all, regardless of age, sex, creed, race or nationality. An adult must accompany children under age 12.

IVV CREDIT: This event is sanctioned by the American Volkssport Association (AVA), a member of the International Federation of Popular Sports (IVV) and counts toward acquisition of IVV Achievement Awards. IVV books may be purchased at the event for \$6.00. New walker packets are available for \$5.00.

AMENITIES: Water will be available at the Start/Finish and at points along the routes. **No Restrooms at the Start, but located about a 5 minute walk from the Start/Finish and along the routes.**

CONDUCT: Participants are reminded that this event is open to all, including families. Please conduct yourself accordingly.
