
DIRECTIONS: <u>Driving N on 135</u>, take exit #244 (Yager Ln.) Drive about 1.2 miles on the access road and turn left on Yager Ln. Yager Ln. will dead end at N. Lamar in about .4 miles. Left on N. Lamar a short distance, ~300yds. And turn right into park. Parking and pavilion will be on your right. <u>Driving S on 135</u>, take exit #245 (Parmer/Yager Ln.) At first traffic light, Parmer Ln. (route 734) go <u>straight</u> through the light, crossing over Parmer. At second traffic light, go right on Yager Ln. till it dead ends at N. Lamar. Left on N. Lamar a short distance, ~300 yds., and turn right into park. Parking and pavilion will be on your right.

HISTORY: Recently a portion of the Northern Walnut Creek Hike and Bike Trail was completed. This allows walkers to go from Walnut Creek Park to Balcones District Park on a concrete path. You are surrounded by nature, you cross over the creek on 9 new bridges, and you experience this woodsy world in the middle of North Austin.

LOCATION Start/Finish: Pavilion at Walnut Creek Park, 12138 N. Lamar Blvd. Austin Tx. 78753

START / FINISH TIMES: Start between 7:30 a.m. and 10:30 a.m., finish by 1:30 p.m.

ROUTE: Both the 5k and 10k routes will walk from Walnut Creek Park toward Balcones District Park along the beautiful, recently completed, cement trail. You will cross Walnut Creek a number of times. The 5k walkers turn around at 2.5k and retrace their steps to the start/finish point, enjoying the trail from a different viewpoint! The 10k walkers continue to Balcones District Park (restrooms) and then reverse their route back to the start/finish.

Please walk on the right side, no more than 2 abreast. This allows bikers to safely pass in the middle.

WALK FEES:

All walkers (Credit or non-credit) are \$3.00. Non-credit children under 12 are \$1.25 to cover AVA fee.

AWARDS: "B" awards from previous walks will be available. Children under 12 are eligible for a free "B" award.

DISCLAIMER: The Colorado River Walkers are not responsible for accidents, injuries, or any lost or stolen items during the event. Reasonable effort will be made to make this a safe, enjoyable event.

EVENT CONDITIONS: The event will be held regardless of weather conditions. All participants (including small children) must carry a Start Card. Walk route twice on same Start Card for additional distance credit. Events are noncompetitive. Walk, jog, or run at your own pace. Pets are allowed on the trail, but must remain on a leash with owner doing cleanup.

Special Programs: City Parks, Bridges, Reference Points, Louisiana Purchase

ELIGIBILITY: Everyone is welcome. These events are open to all, regardless of age, sex, creed, race or nationality. An adult must accompany children under age 12.

IVV CREDIT: This event is sanctioned by the American Volkssport Association (AVA), a member of the International Federation of Popular Sports (IVV) and counts toward acquisition of IVV Achievement Awards. IVV books may be purchased at the event for \$6.00. New Walker packets are available for \$5.00.

AMENITIES: Water and restrooms are available at the Start/Finish and at other places along the route.

Conduct: Participants are reminded that this event is open to all, including families. Please conduct yourself accordingly.
