2. Round Rock Park "Play for All Abilities" discussed by Carol O and a presentation by Doug E. His suggestion is to modify the YRE and Bike routes to go from Brushy Creek to Round Rock in 5K loops. Discussion followed
3. The next TVA meeting is to be held in San Angelo Aug. 3<sup>rd</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup>. No traditional walks planned but the walk boxes for 7 YREs will be available at the meeting, 5 in surrounding counties and 2 in San Angelo. There is topic of discussion about disbanding the TVA.
