Walk Waring

Start at Waring Hall in beautiful downtown Waring between 8 and 11 am. Finish by 2 pm.

ROUTES: The Seesaw Trail (116305-2020) consists of two 5K trails. The first departs Waring on a scenic country road paralleling the Guadalupe River. A slight jog off the main trail on a pastoral lane paralleling a private landing strip leads to a checkpoint where great views are all around. From here all walkers will retrace their steps to Waring Hall. After refreshing, the walk leaves the hall and turns south on a paved county road passing the old rail depot. This lightly traveled road provides typical scenic Hill Country views. After reaching the checkpoint you will return to the start point. The trail is rated 1A. Strollers ok but wheelchairs with difficulty.

SPONSOR: Hill Country Volkssportsverein AVA23/TX09

ELIGIBILITY: Volkssporting is a non-competitive sport and welcomes everyone of all age groups. An adult must accompany children under the age of 12. Pets are welcome but must be kept on a leash. Every participant must carry a validated start card and must stop at the checkpoints.

AWARDS: There will be no "A" award for this event. Various "B" awards will be available for a nominal fee. Children 12 and under may choose a patch or pin award free of charge.

REFRESHMENTS: There will not be a food concession at the start/finish point this year due to Covid-19. Water will be available at the checkpoints.

RESTROOMS are at the start/finish.

FEES: ALL participants must pay a registration fee of \$3.00. Children under 12 walk free for no credit. Donations will be accepted to help defray expenses. No pre-registration.

IVV BOOKS: This event counts toward the acquisition of IVV achievement awards. Bring your books or purchase them at the event. New Walker Packets will also be available for purchase for \$5.00. Purchase price for distance or event books is \$6.00 each.

PARTICIPANTS may complete the walk event twice on one registration the same day.

DIRECTIONS: From San Antonio, take IH 10 West, exit 527 and follow signs to Waring. From Kerrville or Fredericksburg take IH 10 East, exit 524 and follow signs to FM 1621 to Waring. From Austin, take US290 west to US281. Go south to FM473. Turn west and go through Sisterdale staying on Fm473 for 28 miles to Waring Welfare Rd. Turn south for about 3 miles to 205 Ave. C, Waring, TX.
