ELIGIBILITY/TYPE OF EVENT: **Noncompetitive.** Walk, jog or run at your own pace. It is open to all and families are encouraged to participate. Children under age 12 must be accompanied by an adult. Everyone participating **MUST** register and carry a Start card and turn it in at the **FINISH**.

STARTING POINT: St. John's Lutheran Church, Luther Hall, at 315 E. Rosewood Ave., Boerne, TX 78006.

START AND FINISH TIMES: 8:00a.m. to noon. Due to the pandemic there is no pancake breakfast, but **Broadway Daily Bread Bakery is donating a special treat for each walker at the finish table!**

DISTANCES: One 10km walk and one 5km walk. The 10km route may be walked twice on the same start card for 20km Distance Credit.

AWARD: Awards from previous Roadrunners events will be available for a nominal fee. Participants 12 years of age and under who complete the event will receive a **free** award of their choice from the display board.

REGISTRATION: All participants must register and carry a start card. There is no preregistration.

FEES: The fee is \$3.00 for all participants. There are no refunds. Donations are appreciated.

TRAIL: The Trail Rating is 1A; the route is considered easy and is on a paved trail. Easy for wheelchairs and strollers.

WATER & RESTROOMS: Water and restrooms are available at the start/finish and in town.

AVA SPECIAL PROGRAMS: will be listed at the Start Table.
