


DIRECTIONS: Driving N or S on I 35 Take the Cesar Chavez exit, and go **west** on Cesar Chavez about 1.6 miles, crossing Congress Ave. and going under 3 small overpass bridges. Just at the last ball field on your right, turn **right** on a small road. It will bend **left** under Cesar Chavez. After just the length of a football field, turn **right** with Austin High track on your right, and another field on your left. This road is sometimes called Stephen F. Austin Dr. It soon turns into Veterans Dr. near the tennis courts. Park just on left side of tennis courts, with small green restrooms nearby.

Note: Your GPS system might give you a different route, as there are many ways to get to the start point.



HISTORY:

The Johnson Creek Trail is named after Chas. Johnson who built a large home on the Colorado River in 1858. It is now home to the American Legion Post 76. You will visit this site on our volksmarch.

The Ann and Roy Butler Trail is named after former Austin Mayor Roy Butler and his wife Ann, who worked with Lady Bird Johnson to beautify the area around the Colorado River as it goes through Austin and is known as Lady Bird Lake.

LOCATION Start/Finish:

Start point, parking lot and restrooms at Austin High Tennis Center, 1717 W. Cesar Chavez St. Austin Tx. 78703

START / FINISH TIMES: Start between 8:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m., finish by 2:00 p.m.

ROUTE: The walking route is on the west side of I35, very near to Loop 1 (Mopac) and the Colorado River. It consists of 2 loops, each approximately 5k.

The first loop follows Johnson Creek Trail north under Loop 1 to Enfield Rd. (15th St). It returns through a residential neighborhood, past Deep Eddy Pool and the Veterans Memorial.

The second loop is on the Butler trail and circles part of the Colorado River/Lady Bird Lake on the west side of Austin.

WALK FEES:

All walkers (Credit or non-credit) are \$3.00.
Non-credit children under 12 are \$1.25 to cover AVA fee.

AWARDS: "B" awards from previous walks will be available. Children under 12 are eligible for a free "B" award.

DISCLAIMER: The Colorado River Walkers are not responsible for accidents, injuries, or any lost or stolen items during the event. Reasonable effort will be made to make this a safe, enjoyable event.

EVENT CONDITIONS: The event will be held regardless of weather conditions. All participants (including small children) must carry a Start Card. Walk route twice on same Start Card for additional distance credit. Events are noncompetitive. Walk, jog, or run at your own pace. Pets are allowed on the trail, but must remain on a leash with owner doing cleanup.

Special Programs: Veterans Memorial

ELIGIBILITY: Everyone is welcome. These events are open to all, regardless of age, sex, creed, race or nationality. An adult must accompany children under age 12.

IVV CREDIT: This event is sanctioned by the American Volkssport Association (AVA), a member of the International Federation of Popular Sports (IVV) and counts toward acquisition of IVV Achievement Awards. IVV books may be purchased at the event for \$6.00. New Walker packets are available for \$5.00.

AMENITIES: Water and restrooms are available at the Start/Finish and on the walk route.
