

Open since 1998, Alamo Quarry Market is a 580,000 square-foot; open-air complex and a true Texas landmark. Now an inspired destination for shopping, dining and entertainment, it was once home to Alamo Cement Plant that helped build Texas for more than 100 years. Alamo Quarry Market has maintained and integrated some of the original structures of the factory. Regal 16-plex Cinemas is constructed around the original smokestacks. These smokestacks are a main focal point of the center and have become an easily distinguishable landmark visible from the highway.

STARTING POINT: The Corner Bakery Café at Lincoln Heights, Alamo Quarry Market Shopping Center, 225 E. Basse Road, San Antonio, TX 78209

START AND FINISH TIMES: 8:00 a.m. until noon with a walk finish by 3 p.m.

DISTANCES: 10km (6.2 mi) 5km (3.1 mi) the route may be walked twice on the same start card for 20km distance credit.

REGISTRATION: All participants must register and carry a start card. There is no preregistration.

FEES: The fee for all participants is \$3.00.

DONATIONS: Will be most appreciated and are always welcome to help defray event expenses and promote Volkssporting in Texas.

TRAIL: The route is considered easy on sidewalks and paved streets. Trail is rated 1A. Suitable for wheelchairs and strollers.

WATER and RESTROOMS: Water and restrooms available at start/finish and sometimes along the routes. Water is also available at the checkpoint stations.

DISCLAIMER: The sponsors are not liable for accidents, thefts, and/or material damage. Reasonable effort has been made by the sponsors to make this a safe, enjoyable and memorable event.

FOOD AND BEVERAGES: The Corner Bakery has an array of delicious menu items.
