

ABOUT THE TVA MEETING

The meeting of TVA Club representatives will be held at The Inn of the Hills Hotel and Conference Center, Angora Room at 1:00 pm on Saturday.

DIRECTIONS TO THE INN OF THE HILLS: From San Antonio, take IH 10 west, exit 505 and turn right at FM 783 and continue approximately 4 miles to Junction Highway. Turn left at the light and the Inn of the Hills will be on your right.

From the East or North take Hwy 16 South from Fredericksburg to IH 10. Going West on IH 10 take exit 505 and turn right at FM 783. Continue approximately 4 miles to Junction Highway. Turn left at the light and the Inn of the Hills will be on your right.

DIRECTIONS TO CENTER POINT MUSEUM:

FROM INN OF THE HILLS: Exit the hotel turning right on Junction Highway. Continue through Kerrville to intersect with Highway 27, following SH27 for approximately nine miles to the traffic light. Turn right continuing into town and the Museum will be on your right.

FEBRUARY 4 – Kerrville Guadalupe River Trail YRE

START POINT: The Inn of the Hills, 1001 Junction Highway, Kerrville, Texas 78028.

MANNED REGISTRATION: 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm.

DISTANCE: 5K & 10K - rated 1A.

FEBRUARY 5 – Center Point Traditional

START POINT: Center Point Museum, 310 FM 480 or 310 San Antonio Street, Center Point Texas 78010.

START TIME: 8:00 am to 11:00 am.

DISTANCE: 5K & 10K – rated 1A. The route includes the historic district and surrounding countryside with scenic views of the river and dam (built in 1956) and follows a section of the Old Spanish Trail. Walkers will visit the Center Point Cemetery, which has the largest number of burials of Texas Rangers in the state.

FEBRUARY 6 – Kerrville Downtown YRE

START POINT: The Inn of the Hills, 1001 Junction Highway, Kerrville, Texas 78028.

MANNED REGISTRATION: 8:00 am to 10:00 am.

DISTANCE: 5K & 10 K – rated 1A.

If unable to be there for the manned registration times, you are welcome to walk any of the 5 Kerrville YRE's at your convenience. The start box is located in the lobby of the Inn of the Hills, to the left of the stairway.
