**LOCATION:** Gruene Dance Hall Beer Garden  
1281 Gruene Road

**START TIME:** 8:00 AM – 11:00 AM; **Finish** – 2:00 PM

**TRAIL:** The route is rated '1B'. Most of the route will wind through residential and city areas of Gruene. Most of the route will be on paved streets and sidewalks; however, short stretches of unpaved road shoulder make route unsuitable for wheel chairs and strollers.

**FEES:** \$3.00 per walker

**RESTROOMS:** Available at Gruene Hall Beer Garden

**PARKING:** Use lot behind Cotton-Eyed Joe's complex, across from Gruene Hall. Parking is free.

**PETS:** Pets must be kept on a leash at all times.

**WATER/FOOD:** Water will be available at the start/finish. Bring a water bottle to carry on the trail. Food and refreshments will be available at Gruene merchants after the walk (most places will be open by 10:00 AM).

**DIRECTIONS:** Gruene Hall is located at 1281 Gruene Road in the center of historic Gruene Texas. **From Austin or San Antonio** - Exit IH35 at exit 191. Drive toward Canyon Lake on FM306. Turn left at traffic light on Hunter Road and drive into the village of Gruene. **From Boerne** - take TX46 east to New Braunfels. When approaching New Braunfels, take TX46 east/Loop 337 east. Stay on Loop 337 and exit at Ranch Pkwy/Gruene Rd. Turn right on Gruene Road and drive into Gruene.

In its glory days, it was a significant cotton-producing community along the Guadalupe River. The town was redeveloped and restored in the the 1970's and 1980's and now has a thriving tourist business. Most of Gruene is listed in the National Register of Historic Places. The historic district has many original buildings that now house shops, restaurants, wine tasting rooms and inns.
