The walk will include the historic King William District that once was farm land belonging to the Mission San Antonio de Valero, commonly known as the Alamo. Germans began to settle in this area in the mid 19th century. In 1968 the King William neighborhood became San Antonio's first designated historic district. In 1972 it was listed in the register of National Historic Districts. Maifest is the traditional German celebration of the arrival of spring. There should be live German music and singing and the chicken dance!! A fun time for all.

**REGISTRATION:** All participants must register and carry a start card. There is no preregistration.

**FEES:** The fee is \$3.00 for all participants. There are no refunds. Donations are appreciated to help defray event expenses and promote Volkssporting in Texas. Purchase of a start card also provides free admission to the Maifest at the Männerchor.

**DIRECTIONS TO START POINT:** 422 Pereida, San Antonio From I-37 ( east of downtown ) exit to Cesar Chavez and travel west or from I-10/I-35 ( west of downtown ) to Cesar Chavez and travel east. From either direction turn south onto South Alamo. Continue past South St. Mary's St. for 3 blocks to an intersection with a light. Pereida is at that intersection.
